

Application Information

Items Needed To Be Attached To The Application:

1. Copy of **Orders to Fort Stewart** stating the Soldier and his dependants stationed at Fort Stewart are authorized.
2. If coming from another posts a copy of **Clearing Papers** from previous duty station proving Soldier cleared last housing assignment.
3. If this is your *first duty station*, a copy of your **Military Contract** showing the day you signed on active duty.
4. Copy **Marriage License** if recently married, OR copy of **Military ID Card** for Soldier and spouse.
5. Copy of **Birth Certificates** for children OR Copy of **DEERS** for children from outside the marriage.
6. Copy of **Current LES** (first of the month).
7. **General POA** (Power of Attorney) to accept application and pick up a housing list. Specific **GME SPOA** (Special Power of Attorney) necessary for signing of lease to start BAH allotment.
8. To avoid excessive waiting time you can fill out your application online at www.fortstewartfamilyhousing.com but you must return with all supporting documents to be officially placed on the waiting list.

Determining Eligibility Date:

1. If a Soldier does not apply within the 30 day window, the eligibility date will be the date of application.
2. If a Soldier is PCSing to Fort Stewart and is within the 30 day window, his eligibility date is the day they left their last duty station, and can be determined with their clearing papers.
3. If a Soldier is coming from an unaccompanied tour, i.e. Korea, their eligibility date is determined from, and back-dated to, the date he departed their previous duty station for the unaccompanied tour, with a maximum of a 14 month credit.
4. If this is the first duty station for the Soldier and the Soldier was already married, the eligibility date is the date of entry into the military. If the Soldier was married after date of entry the eligibility date is date of marriage.
